

SASKATOON AIRPORT AUTHORITY
2020 SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES

LANDING FEES:

All landing fees are assessed against jet or turboprop aircraft at a rate per 1000 kgs or fraction thereof.

Minimum flight landing charge for non-airline jet or turboprop engine: \$13.00

Effective March 1, 2020 there will be a 4.0% increase in the Landing Fee rate schedule as indicated below:

GENERAL TERMINAL FEES / BORDER CLEARANCE FEES:

General Terminal fees are a per arrival charge for using the terminal facility and for the use of a loading bridge and the apron parking area for a period not to exceed 90 minutes. An additional Border Clearance Fee is charged to all non-domestic arrivals for using the dedicated Customs area. Both fees are based on the seating capacity of the aircraft.

Effective March 1, 2020 the General Terminal Fee and the Border Clearance Fee will be increased by 4.0% as indicated below:

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AIRPORT RENT SURCHARGE:

A surcharge will be added to all landing fees, general terminal user fees and border clearance fees to recover airport rent payable by the Saskatoon Airport Authority to the Federal Government of Canada. **The Federal Government Airport Rent Surcharge will be 22.0% effective March 1, 2020.**

AIRCRAFT PARKING FEES:

Aircraft parking fees are assessed based on aircraft weight and on the length of stay. No minimum stay is required. Aircraft arriving that depart within the allotted 90-minute connection time will not be assessed a parking charge.

Aircraft Parking Fees will increase by 4% effective March 1, 2020 are as indicated below:

Monthly or annual aircraft parking fees are dependent on availability, location and prevailing market rates.

AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT FEE (AIF)

Effective June 1, 2020 for tickets sold on or after March 1, 2020

Note: Rate subject to GST. Rate based on enplaning passengers on all publicly available air transport services where such services are in accordance with a published schedule and where there is a customer charge per seat. Non-signatory airlines to be billed based on statistics provided to the Authority.

*The airline handling fee for signatory airlines is 7% which rate will decrease to 4% in 2020 upon execution of a new AIF agreement.

AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT LEVY (AIL)

For those jet and turboprop driven aircraft whose departure will be exempt from having passengers subject to the Airport Improvement Fee ("AIF") there will be an Airport Infrastructure Levy ("AIL"). The "AIL" will be equivalent to 10% of the in-Province passenger AIF rate multiplied by the seating capacity of the aircraft. The seating capacity of the aircraft is to be determined based upon the general design configuration for the aircraft, if available or based upon a ratio of 2.5 seats per 1000 kg MTOW for those aircraft not generally configured for passenger traffic. The in-Province AIF will be \$6.00 per seat effective June 1, 2020 therefore the infrastructure levy for applicable aircraft will be \$0.60 per seat effective the same date.

VARIOUS CHARGES AND FEES:

1. LOADING BRIDGE AND APRON USE CHARGES:

The fee for the use of loading bridges and common use aprons has been included in the General Terminal User Fee for those aircraft that arrive and depart within the allotted 90-minute connection time. For aircraft exceeding the allotted 90-minute connection time, a fee for the use of the loading bridge and common use apron is included in the daily aircraft parking rate.

2. CRASH, FIRE, RESCUE SERVICE FOR ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES OUTSIDE OF SCHEDULE:

Crash, Fire, Rescue Services have been extended to 24 hours therefore there is no longer a separate fee for arrivals or departures outside of the schedule. Crash, Fire, Rescue Services are included in the Landing Fees.

3. MOBILE REFUELLER REGISTRATIONS:

\$0.033 per kilogram x gross vehicle weight in kilograms

4. CONCESSION FEE FOR FUEL & OIL DISPENSED BY FBO'S:

Effective March 1, 2020, the following rates will be in effect:

\$0.10 per liter for AvGas

\$0.02 per liter for Oil

5. INTEREST ON OVERDUE ACCOUNTS

Interest is charged on all overdue accounts after 60 days at a rate of 1.5% per month or 18% per annum

6. FLIGHT INFORMATION DISPLAY (FIDS)

There is no longer a separate fee for the use of the FIDS system.

7. GLYCOL COST RECOVERY

Out of pocket costs incurred by the Saskatoon Airport Authority relative to the application of glycol by Airlines at the Saskatoon Airport will be recovered from the Airlines on a prorated basis based upon the reported glycol volumes applied.

8. SECURITY ACCESS FEE

A monthly fee of \$5.00 will be assessed for each individual requiring access privileges to the secure area of the airport. The fee will be charged to the representative Company or Individual who authorized the issuance of the secure area access privileges.
