

HOLIDAY TRAVEL TIPS

MORE TIME = LESS STRESS

Due to high holiday traffic, the airport gets very busy with extra and full flights. Please allow extra time for parking, checking in, and going through security.

- Arrive at the airport at least 90 minutes before your boarding time for domestic flights
- Arrive 120 minutes before boarding for international flights.
- Flights direct to the US will be subject to additional screening at check-in, the screening area, and boarding.
- Streamline your arrival by checking in online and pre-printing your own boarding passes.

KEEP IT UNWRAPPED

- Research any checked baggage restrictions and costs with your airline.
- Make sure to keep your gifts unwrapped.
- Wrapped gifts may need to be unwrapped when going through security so plan to wrap presents at your destination.

\$10 / day

jetSet is ideal for travelers looking for a lower cost parking option. Located at the corner of 45th Street & Airport Road. A shuttle to and from the air terminal building is available free of charge 24/7. There is a call button located in the jetSet shelter located in the center of the parking lot. Alternatively, there is a 12 minute walking trail that connects this remote parking lot and the air terminal building. *Note that jetSet does not have electrified parking stalls.



\$16 / day or \$2.50 per hour

Located just outside the main terminal building, StandardXE long-term parking offers the same close proximity service that you've been used to, and includes electrified parking stalls.



\$22 / day or \$2.50 per hour

Located front and centre, ExpressXE offers designated short-term parking for the meeters & greeters or travelers that will be embarking on a quick trip.



\$30 / day

ValetXE parking is perfect for those guests looking for a premier service or for those who are running late. And for those heading to warm destinations, guests can check their coats at the ValetXE desk. ValetXE is located curbside with dedicated terminal access via the valet lounge.



The cell phone parking lot is available for family and friends waiting for traveling guests to arrive. Due to high traffic, waiting on the public curb is not permitted. The public lane is only available for immediate drop off or pick up. Once the passenger has received their baggage and is waiting under the canopy, meeters and greeters can proceed to the curb from the cell phone lot to collect them.



Rideshare is accessible through dedicated applications. The pick-up and drop-off area is located on the public curb at the far north end, near door 1. All pick ups and drop offs are restricted to this location.
