Reporting directly to the Mobile / Surface Supervisor, the Mechanic has overall responsibility of this safety sensitive role to perform high quality maintenance, diagnostics, overhauling and repairs to the fleet of unique equipment specific to the Saskatoon Airport, as well as Saskatoon Airport Authority support vehicles and equipment.

During the winter season, the Mechanic will assist our Airfield Team with snow removal activities when operational requirements demand. The hours of work for this position will be Monday to Friday, 7:00 to 4:30 during the summer months, and during the winter season it is anticipated that a Morning / Evening shift pattern will be implemented.

This position is an integral part of Airport Operations and is required to ensure all equipment runs smoothly in order to maintain safe operations on our airfield.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Repair and maintain a diverse fleet of airport vehicles and heavy equipment, including: off-highway trucks and trailers, airport fire trucks, snow clearing equipment, agricultural equipment and construction equipment utilizing a variety of hand and power tools and equipment. On occasion, emergency repairs may need to be done on the airfield in poor weather conditions.
2. Maintains, repairs and overhauls all fixed and mobile gasoline and diesel-powered vehicles and equipment at the Airport utilizing a variety of hand and power tools and equipment.
3. Carry out preventative maintenance, including regularly schedule maintenance servicing on all equipment to keep down time to a minimum. Maintain detailed records of work performed, materials used and condition reports on all equipment.
4. As part of a preventative maintenance program and in emergency situations, inspects, repairs, overhauls various diesel-powered generating plants.
5. Perform modifications on all vehicles and equipment to meet increased performance requirements and to improve reliability and safety.
6. Performs inspection and safety checks. Inspect units and test various systems and components to determine specific problems. Conduct operational tests where necessary.

7. Adjust, repair and replace parts and components of primarily heavy equipment using hand tools and other specialized equipment. Tests and adjusts repaired systems to manufacturer's performance specifications.
8. Diagnoses and repairs a wide variety of electrical, pneumatic and hydraulic diesel systems, and associated components.
9. Troubleshooting, disassemble, repair, overhaul, assemble, install, adjust, test, maintain, document and modify components and systems on all vehicles and equipment.
10. Maintains vehicle records by recording service and repairs through a Maintenance Management System, and reviews all work orders with the Mobile / Surface Supervisor.
11. Inventory Management: Maintains an accurate inventory of parts, tools and supplies.
12. Contact suppliers regarding parts. If necessary, pick up parts and materials.
13. Automotive electrical repairs and troubleshooting.
14. Performs minor welding duties.
15. Participate in the Safety, Security and Emergency Response programs.
16. Deal tactically with any emergency occurring airside, ensuring that airside operating areas are safely maintained, assisting emergency personnel to ensure that public and employees are safe and secure at all times.
17. Adhere to and participate in the Safety Management System, Wildlife Management and Occupational Health & Safety Programs.
18. As directed by Mobile / Surface Supervisor, assist the Airfield Team during the winter schedule, with snow and ice control on airport paved surfaces through the use of a variety of heavy equipment and material applications.
19. Will be required to work overtime evenings and weekends as necessary to co-ordinate and assist with special projects and emergency repairs.
20. May be required to provide work direction and training to other staff.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The equipment maintained includes cars, trucks, Airport snow blowers, runway sweepers, front-end loaders, graders, bulldozers, airport emergency service vehicles and foam and dry trucks. Various automotive electrical testing equipment, shop equipment, welding equipment and other hand and power operated tools are used. Specific equipment maintenance training is provided when required. The Authority provides our Mechanics with all the tools that they need to do a job well done.

- Strong attention to detail with the ability to minimize errors

- Reliable
- Considerable knowledge of the operation and use of current test equipment
- Knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions of the trade
- Knowledge of electronic engines and transmissions, diesel and air brake systems and associated components
