

## **ADDENDUM NUMBER 3**

**Request for Proposals – Professional Engineering and Administrative Services  
for  
Pavement Repairs on Aprons 1 (de-ice pad) 2, 3, and 4  
at  
Saskatoon John G. Diefenbaker International Airport**

### **1.0 GENERAL**

This Addendum will form part of and be included in the Request For Proposals package originally issued for the above named project and no consideration will be given to requests for extras to this opportunity due to the Proponent not being familiar with this Addendum.

All parts bound to or referenced at length form part of this Addendum Number 3.

### **2.0 ADDENDA**

#### **2.1 Insurance**

**Question:**

In SECTION III – INSURANCE, Schedule of Insurance to be Supplied by the Consultant, C. Professional Liability, does the SAA require that the Professional Liability insurance “to be project specific”. Generally project specific professional liability insurance is required only for very large projects with a large number of subconsultants. This insurance is generally expensive and may cost upwards of 5% of the entire consulting fee. In past SAA engineering RFP’s over the previous 3+ years, the “project specific” requirement for professional liability insurance was absent, or was routinely deleted by Addendum.

**Answer:**

Proponent to provide “project specific” insurance as noted in the RFP.

#### **2.2 Testing Allowances**

**Question:**

In Addendum No.2, Section 2.2, Second Paragraph, states the following “If, during construction, the testing exceeds the expected amount by more than 10%, SAA reserves the right to review and approve additional testing on a case by case basis, including the right to not pay for additional testing of the 5% upcharge”.

For bidding purposes can the SAA provide a minimum scope of work for the QA program (concrete cylinders, concrete air/slump, concrete compressive strength, aggregate sieve/proctor, compaction testing etc.) or provide a cash allowance value that will be carried for all proponents?

**Answer:**

Section V, Schedule B, Item 1.0 Fees in the RFP notes that the SAA will provide an allowance up to \$15,000.00 for all required and approved testing deemed necessary.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.

Receipt of this Addendum #3 is to be identified in the form of a covering letter and submitted with all interested responses to this proposal call.
