What type of COVID test do I need for entering another country?

- When travelling to another country from Canada, it is important to check airline and country requirements for COVID testing and restrictions for your destination.

What type of COVID test do I need to travel in Canada and/or to enter Canada?

- Some other Canadian provinces and territories do have quarantine restrictions. Passengers are responsible for knowing the rules of their final destinations. Please consult your airline or the provincial government website of your destination for additional information. There are no restrictions for travellers returning to Saskatchewan from another province.
- Permanent residents of Canada and US citizens who are fully vaccinated will need to download the [ArriveCan](#) app before they return to Canada. Then they need to upload their vaccination proof to the app before they return to Canada and show proof of a negative PCR test.
- These fully vaccinated travellers will not be required to quarantine upon arrival to Canada, however a quarantine plan must be prepared in advance in case it is deemed needed by the Canadian Border Services Agency.

- Children under 12 do not have to quarantine upon arrival in Canada but must travel with a fully vaccinated adult, show a negative PCR test, and avoid large gatherings, school and daycare upon return.

Can we wait in the terminal when picking up or dropping off a friend or family member?

• Yes, guests are welcome in the terminal pre-security area. Masks are mandatory. You can park in our short-term parking lot while you wait. Proof of vaccine is not required to enter the airport.

Do I need to wear a mask in the terminal?

• Transport Canada requires all air passengers to have a non-medical mask or face covering to cover their mouth and nose during travel. Travellers are also required to wear non-medical masks through screening and in the post-security area. Masks are mandatory for all guests pre-security.

Has Saskatoon lost its International Status?

- Independent from COVID-19 federal restrictions, no, Saskatoon has not lost its ability to operate international flights.
- There is new Canadian international designation published by Transport Canada that provides additional guidance to ensure airports seeking the designation for the first time or continuing to use the international designation meet all required criteria.
- The deadline for Transport Canada to review and accept that Saskatoon meets the criteria is mid-2022 and we do not expect any interruption to regular (non-COVID restricted) operations.

Can Saskatoon operate international flights at this time?

- No. As part of the Government of Canada COVID-19 restrictions on international travel, as of January 2021, international port of entry flights were restricted to only being operated in and out of Calgary (YYC), Montreal (YUL), Toronto (YYZ), and Vancouver (YVR).
- As of August 9, 2021 international flights are permitted to be operated at five additional Canadian airports that currently have pre-clearance for US Customs including Halifax (YHZ), Quebec City (YQB), Ottawa (YOW), Winnipeg (YWG), and Edmonton (YEG).
