

Entering Canada during COVID-19

Travellers entering Canada must follow the rules set out by the Emergency Orders under the Quarantine Act to help reduce the spread of COVID-19. This includes screening at the border and mandatory quarantine or isolation for 14 days. Travellers are expected to make quarantine plans, within their own means, in advance of arrival and are required to report any symptoms of COVID-19.

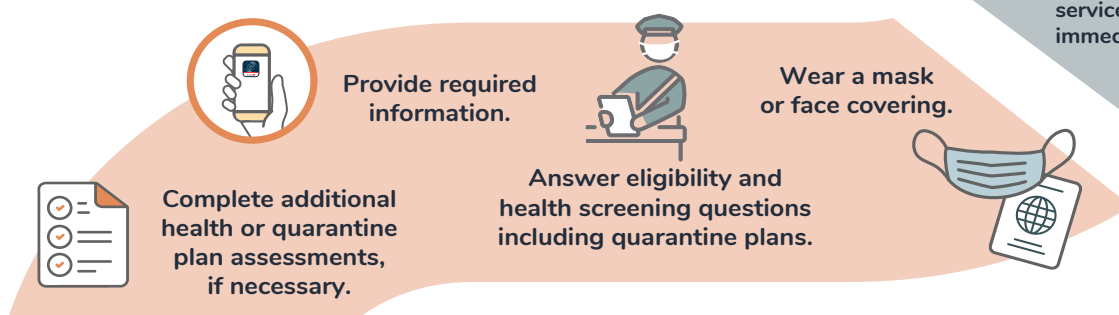
